DISABILITY RIGHTS

- Beyond Disability + Teachers Guide (26 min.)** \$200 Institutional, \$100 Small Org., \$40 Individual
The Empowered Fe Fes (slang for female), a group of young women with disabilities, hit the streets of Chicago on a quest to discover the difference between how they see themselves and how others see them.
- Doin' It: Sex, Disability & Videotape (35 min.)** \$200 Institutional, \$100 Small Org., \$40 Individual
The Empowered Fe Fes, a peer group of young women aged 16 to 24 with differing disabilities, strike again with their second video production, an insightful investigation into the truths about sex and disability.
- Why They Gotta Do Me Like That? (35 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
The Empowered Fe Fes Take On Bullying. Young women with disabilities show us how we can work together to understand and stop discrimination in school, particularly against people with disabilities.

LGBTQ YOUTH ACTIVISM

- HIV: Hey, It's Viral! * (20 min.)** \$200 Institutional, \$100 Small Org., \$40 Individual
This video uses a sex-positive and LGBTQ-inclusive educational approach as a practical alternative to abstinence-only education. The voices of HIV+ youth encourage their peers to combat the spread of HIV/AIDS through safer-sex.

- Can LGBTQ + School = Safe? (28 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
Can LGBTQ+ Schools=Safe? shows how to start a Gay-Straight Alliance (GSA) as an activist solution to sexuality-based discrimination and anti-gay violence in school.
- A Fish Almost Eaten By a Shark (17 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
A 17-year-old Latina tries to make a video, *How to Start a Gay-Straight Alliance in Your High School*, and is harassed by the principal. The video paints a sobering picture of school and family life for GLBT youth.

WOMEN & JUSTICE

- Turning a Corner (60 min.)** \$200 Institutional, \$100 Small Org., \$40 Individual
Created with Prostitution Alternatives Roundtable, this video tells the stories of people involved in the sex trade and their efforts to raise public awareness of systemic injustice. Told on the streets of Chicago where the women once worked.
- Voices in Time (36 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
A window into the lives of women who have served time in prison. Women share their experiences before, in, and after prison, examining the relationship between the prison system, and poor communities and communities of color.
- What We Leave Behind (21 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
Formerly incarcerated women use personal stories, poetry, group discussion, and street interviews to analyze the issues women face in prison and the impact of their incarceration on their children.

WOMEN & GIRLS' ACTIVISM

- Girls' Theory: Me-Search Research (24 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
Teenage girls use media to explore their own lives and the world around them, covering topics such as violence, stereotypes of women, sex, relationships, reputation, and the future.
- Real Talk: Engaging Young Men**
- As Allies to End Violence Against Women (28 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
"The Young Women's Action Team" asks young and adult men what a male ally looks like and how do we build the movement to stop violence against women. This video speaks to youth who want to confront gender-based violence in their communities.
- Respect Me, Don't Media Me (30 min.)** \$175 Institutional, \$75 Small Org., \$30 Individual
"Sisters Empowering Sisters" examines the portrayal of women in music videos and advertising. It asks: What does this kind of portrayal mean for young women? How does it affect our lives, our decisions, our relationships? And what can we do to change it?
